• Pediatric Intensive Care Unit set up at Surya Sahyadri Hospital

A state-of-the-art Pediatric Intensive Care Unit has been set up at Surya Sahyadri Hospital in Pune. The 10-bed ICU unit including cardiac care was inaugurated on 8th April 2022. The primary objective of the ICU is serving the economically weaker sections of the society. It has been technically designed with dual mode, meaning that the primary objective is to treat Pediatric patients but if the need arises, even an adult patient can be treated in the same facility.

The equipments donated includes eight ventilators, USG machines, ECG machines, Dual Chamber Pacemaker, Ultrasonic nebulizer and others.

The donation to the Surya hospital is one of several CSR donations for children and needy people, which the Interpump Group companies are doing in India.


• Vanavasi Kalyana Project

Vanavasi Kalyana is an NGO working for the holistic development of tribal communities of India residing in inaccessible areas like hilly terrains and forest. Their mission is to empower them through education, make them self-reliant and provide them basic health care facilities. The Interpump Group Companies have helped Vanavasi Kalyana Charitable Trust in construction of a new building by demolishing an old building which had improper ventilation, unusable toilets and unavailability of skill development training facility. The new building is now utilized to provide hostel facilities, running a vocational center for the tribals, training the 'karyakarthas', teachers etc.

• Katkari Community Development Project

The Katkari Community has been recognized to be a particularly vulnerable tribal group of Maharashtra. Recognizing the need to help the tribe, Inoxpa India has made donation for the betterment of this community.

204 regular sessions over the period of 2 years were conducted for the children of this community. The main focus of these sessions was inculcating good hygiene habits, creating education awareness and developing studying skills among the children. Apart from this the children were taken for educational study tours to city parks, motivational camp for personality development, sports etc. was organized.

To understand the needs and problems of the community a study was conducted by Jnana Probodhini Foundation where the focus was on education, culture, health and financial literacy. A small get together was organized for the tribe to discuss their problems openly.

2 self-help groups were started for the women of the community.

Due to illiteracy and being far away in remote area, the Katkari community was unaware of the spread of Covid-19. An awareness drive for the same was organized.

Apart from this Aadhar Card drive and health checkups were also organized for the community.
